Open Knitting and Crochet \$25 for 3 sessions \$10 for 1 session

"Open" means you may work on a project of your choice and the instructor will help you with your specific needs. When you join the Open class the spot is yours for as long as you choose to come.

We are offering two times for this class:

Tuesday or Wednesday afternoons 1:00 - 3:00 with Arline ... Knit or crochet.

Multi-directional Scarf \$15 Sat., October 28 12:00 - 2:00 Barbara Harris-Pruitt

This wonderful scarf will make a great gift. It's from the book Modular Knitting, and it's packed with lots of projects. We have a couple samples of this scarf for you to see. The book will be on sale for the class.

Traditional Fair Isle \$65 Friday, Oct. 13 & 20 1:00 - 3:00 Dorothy Bosket

This class fee includes five skeins of Heilo and two sessions. Dorothy will teach you the basic terminology of Fair Isle knitting and very easy charting.

Felted Clogs \$30 Sat., October 7 & 21 12:00 - 2:30 Marge Parks

Back by popular demand! This class is two sessions, two weeks apart to make it easier for you to finish. Bet you can't make just one pair! (Not recommended for beginners, as you need to have some working knowledge of knitting basics.) Beginners could sign up for Open Knitting to make these.

Barbara's Sock Class \$30 Sat., November 4 & 11 11:00 - 1:00 Barbara Harris-Pruitt

Learn how to make the best fitting socks ... from the toe up! This technique also uses two circular needles. We recommend DK or worsted weight for your first pair. A copy of the pattern is included in the class fee and has instructions for any weight yarn.

Handed Mittens \$20 Sat., December 2 12:00 - 2:00 Barbara Harris-Pruitt

What are handed mittens? It is one for the right hand, and one for the left. You will be given the pattern in class. You can't have too many mittens!

Felted Tote \$15 Sat., September 30 1:00 - 3:00 Jeannie King

Back by *more* popular demand ... this handy, easy tote is knit in the round. A good project for all skill levels.

Lace Knitting \$35 Fri., October 20 1:00 - 3:00 Dorothy Bosket

This introduction to lace knitting will include charting and making a lace sample. The class fee includes the skein of fingering yarn you will need. Just bring size 5 knitting needles and a notebook to class.

Moebius Basket \$20 Check with us for this date Deb Jaworowicz

Stop by to see this charming little basket! It's from Cat Bordhi's Second Treasury of Magical Knitting. Purchase of the book is required ... we'll discount it for this class.

Intarsia ... without bobbins! \$30 Fri., October 6 1:00 - 3:00 Dorothy Bosket

This is a technique class for knitting with multiple colors. We will make a small sampler. Bring an assortment of worsted weight yarns from your stash. We can swap colors in class ... the more the better!

Make a Gift Free Sat., November 18 1:00 Jeannie King

This is a demonstration of how to embellish with needle-felting. Techniques and helpful hints will be given for needle-felting a felted needlecase!!

Store Policies:

Class cancellations ... If *we* cancel a class that you have pre-paid, you may have a store credit or a refund. If *you* cancel a pre-paid class it must be done no closer than 7 days before the class date for a refund.
